Overview:

The Michigan State Youth Soccer Association seeks multiple full-time or part-time interns to assist the State Office with various tasks. MSYSA offers internship positions that focus on coaching, events/operations, and marketing. All internship positions are unpaid. MSYSA will work with interns to complete reasonable aspects of their schools' internship curricula. Interns will work in the State Office in Plymouth, Michigan, and report to the MSYSA Executive Director.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be able to pass a criminal history background check
- Applicants must complete SafeSport training
- Knowledge of soccer and/or youth sports is preferred
- Weekends may be required for special events
- Applicant will be an energetic team player with solid communication and organizational skills
- Applicant will be able to work on multiple projects with minimal supervision while adhering to deadlines
- Applicants must be proficient with all Microsoft Office programs.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Some college preferred.

Degree Program/Relevant Majors:

- Some college preferred.

Practical Experience:

- Minimum experience in sport related field. Sports degree, business degree or similar related field preferred. Solid understanding of the soccer environment. Proven organizational and time management skills. Ability to handle and prioritize multiple assignments.

Minimum Technical Requirements:

- Proficiency with Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, databases, calendar software and ability to learn new software applications quickly.

Travel Requirements:

- Occasional weekend work required as directed by supervisor.
- Ability to travel domestically as directed by supervisor.

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to lift 40 lbs. with or without assistance.
